WHAT DRIVES TIM

While I understand the need for income to thrive and contribute at home and in our communities, it's the work I've led as a volunteer that fills my bucket. I founded a not-for-profit called Hooked on Hockey that provides summer hockey programs for local children. As co-founder and president of the Randy Jones and Family Foundation (which operated over a five-year mandate), I helped send donations in excess of \$650,000 to the Saint John Regional Hospital Neonatal, Paediatric, and Juvenile Diabetes units. And, each year, we award \$40,000 in scholarships so that children from low-income families can attend our Forest School or summer camps. My mandate aligns with sharing, caring, and paying it forward—all for the greater good.




